6. Put up streamers at key locations announcing the celebration of the Civil Engineering Month and other similar information campaigns/activities that would attract attention and support to the celebration such as social media posts and the like
7. Printed News release on the activities of the chapter during the CE Month Celebration in a local or national paper and/or in the digital media platforms/newspapers
8. Sponsorship and Delegation to the 2020 PICE Virtual National Convention and Technical Conference

2. Deadline for submission of digital copy of entries is on **December 7, 2020, 5:00 PM** thru email at picenatl@pice.org.ph and awards.pice@gmail.com. Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted.
3. **Non-compliance with the above guidelines shall be automatically disqualified.**
