PICE NATIONAL AWARDS 2020 Implementing Guidelines

A. The PICE National Awards to be given annually are categorized as follows:

1. **Most Outstanding PICE Chapter Award**
2. **Chapter Special Awards**
 - 2.1 **Most Outstanding Community Project**
 - 2.2 **Most Outstanding Newsletter**
3. **PICE Special Awards**
 - 3.1 **Most Outstanding Chapter President**
 - 3.2 **Most Outstanding Regional Coordinator**

B. To obtain objectivity in the selection, there will be four (4) Awards 2020 classifications

- A – Chapters with more than 900 members on record
- B – Chapters with more than 400 but less than 900 members on record
- C – Chapters with less than 400 members on record
- D – International Chapters

C. Only one (1) winner in each Classification under each Category, will be selected:

1. **MOST OUTSTANDING PICE CHAPTER AWARD**

- Classification B
- Classification C
- Classification D

2. **CHAPTER SPECIAL AWARDS**

2.1. **Most Outstanding Community Project**

- Classification A
- Classification B
- Classification C
- Classification D

2.2. **Most Outstanding Newsletter**

- Classification A

- Classification C
- Classification D

3. **PICE Special Awards**

- 3.1 **Most Outstanding Chapter President (*to be given to the most outstanding chapter per classification*)**
- 3.2 **Most Outstanding Regional Coordinator**

1. The selection shall be based on **The Evaluation Criteria** and **Scoring System** prepared by the PICE National Awards Committee.
2. The Most Outstanding PICE Chapter Awards Evaluation Criteria shall be composed of two (2) parts.
 - Part 1 – Documented Activities and Programs
 - Part 2 – Audio Visual Presentation – Maximum of 5 minutes
3. Entry/ies must be submitted electronically (in pdf) and must correspond to the activities listed on the evaluation guide/scoring system. A link where the entry/ies can be downloaded should be emailed at picenatl@pice.org.ph and awards.pice@gmail.com on or before the given deadline.

4. The period of selection should cover the activities of the chapter for the November 2019 and October 2020.
5. The selection shall be based on the recommendations of the Awards Committee composed of a Chairman and Members designated/approved by the National Board. The decision of the Awards Committee shall be considered final. In case of an appeal or request for reconsideration, the National Board will deliberate and render the final decision.
6. In case of a tie in the final scores, the committee shall call for a chapter interview via zoom. The interview shall compose of question and answer activity that shall focus on the chapter's achievements that makes them the best. The committee members shall vote for the final winner. Conflict of interest shall be addressed through the composition of the committee.
7. The corresponding awards, i.e. trophies; and/or cash incentives, shall be given by the National Board of Directors thru the National Secretariat. The list of cash prizes is presented below which will be payable to the winning Chapters.


